1 About this career

This is the Delhi Police technical post recruited through the Staff Selection Commission whose work is running the police communications system. Assistant Wireless Operators and Tele-Printer Operators handle police wireless messages, control room communications, and the operation and upkeep of the equipment. In any police action the first thing that must work is communication — a message reaching a patrol vehicle, coordination from the control room, information moving quickly in an emergency — and it runs through this cadre. The most important thing about this post is the second limb of its qualification, which very little material states clearly: 10+2 with science and mathematics, OR a National Trade Certificate in the trade of Mechanic-cum-Operator Electronic Communication System. That means a student who did not take science in Class 11 is still not shut out — the post stays open through the ITI route.

2 At a glance

Minimum qualification	Passed 10+2 (Senior Secondary) from a recognised Board WITH science and mathematics as subjects; OR a National Trade Certificate (NTC) in the trade of Mechanic-cum-Operator Electronic Communication System
Recruiting body	Through the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) — the employer is the Delhi Police
Age limit	18 to 27 years. For widows, divorced women and women judicially separated, the upper limit is admissible up to 35 for Unreserved, 38 for OBC and 40 for SC/ST

3 What you need

INTERESTS

- An interest in electronics, communications and equipment
- The setting of a control room and emergency communications
- Technical work carried out inside a police organisation

ABILITIES

- Technical understanding — recognising a fault in equipment and handling it
- Alertness and concentration, since one missed message in communications changes the outcome
- Clear, brief communication under pressure

KEY SKILLS

- Operating wireless equipment and doing basic maintenance on it
- Control room procedures and message logs
- Physical fitness, since a physical test is a stage of selection
- A grounding in electronics and communication systems
- Practical use of computers and communication software
- A Class 12 level base in science and mathematics — the paper is set at that level

4 How to get there

- 1 There are two routes and both are equally valid — which is the most useful fact about this post. First: pass Class 12 with science and mathematics from a recognised Board. Second: obtain a National Trade Certificate (NTC) from an ITI in the trade of Mechanic-cum-Operator Electronic Communication System.
- 2 Pay particular attention to the second route, because it opens the door for many students who assume they are ineligible. If you did not take science in Class 11, or chose the ITI path after Class 10, this post is still open to you — provided you did that specific trade. It is one of the few central posts on this portal where an ITI certificate is placed on a par with 10+2, and knowing that is decisive for a good many students.

- 3 Match the name of the trade carefully. The notice names a specific trade — Mechanic-cum-Operator Electronic Communication System. Any electronics-related ITI trade will not serve in its place, so before taking admission to an ITI, check the trade name against the wording in the notice.
- 4 Your age must be between 18 and 27. One provision is particularly worth knowing: for widows, divorced women and women judicially separated, the upper age limit is admissible up to 35 for the Unreserved category, 38 for OBC and 40 for SC/ST. Relaxations for other categories are also set out in the notice.
- 5 Prepare physically alongside, because although this is a technical post it is a police post and selection includes physical tests. Those standards are given in the notice and are deliberately not printed here, because they differ by category and gender.
- 6 Apply online when the notice appears on the Commission's website.

MAIN EXAMS

- The two-route structure of the qualification is the most important thing about this post and needs to be understood exactly. The notice says: passed 10+2 with science and mathematics as subjects; OR an NTC in the trade of Mechanic-cum-Operator Electronic Communication System. Note that this is "or", not "and". On this portal that is unusual: some CHSL posts require science with mathematics and offer no alternative, so there the Class 11 decision becomes final. Here it is not — one specific ITI trade can reverse that decision.
- An age provision attaches here that this page states expressly, because it changes who may apply. The general band is 18 to 27, but for widows, divorced women and women judicially separated the upper limit is admissible up to 35 for Unreserved, 38 for OBC and 40 for SC/ST. This provision is routinely omitted from summaries, and when it is omitted, women who are in fact eligible conclude that they are not.
- The practical consequence for readers of this portal is large. Many students in Rajasthan take the ITI route after Class 10, often because it is cheaper and leads to employment sooner. Those students are generally told that an ITI leads to technical and industrial jobs rather than to uniformed government posts. This post is an exception to that belief, and at Head Constable rank — one step above constable. For a student taking ITI admission who wants government service later, the choice of trade matters directly here.
- Selection runs in several stages: a computer-based written examination, physical endurance and standards tests, and the stages that follow. The notice itself states that the level of the question paper will be Class 12 level. That means a candidate coming through the ITI route will need to prepare science and mathematics up to Class 12 level even though their formal qualification is the NTC — a practical point worth knowing in advance.

- One caution: pay matrix level numbers do not mean the same thing in the state and at the Centre. Central Level 4 is ₹25,500, while the numbers in the Rajasthan matrix carry different values. Compare the rupee figures, not the level numbers.

FEES

Both routes are inexpensive, and that is this post's practical strength. Class 12 with science and mathematics at a government school costs next to nothing. The ITI route is cheap too — the Mechanic-cum-Operator Electronic Communication System trade at a government ITI carries very low fees and can be taken straight after Class 10, so it is practical for families for whom the cost of study after Class 12 is difficult. Check one thing before taking admission: the trade name must match exactly the name given in the notice, because another electronics-like trade will not serve for this post. That check is free and saves two years spent in the wrong trade. For preparation the Commission publishes the syllabus and past papers free; note that the paper is set at Class 12 level, so a candidate on the ITI route will need to prepare science and mathematics to that level. Physical practice costs nothing on any open ground. For students of Rajasthan from the SC, ST, OBC, MBC, EWS and minority categories, SSC and Constable examinations are included in the Mukhyamantri Anuprati Coaching Yojana.

6 What the work is like

WHERE YOU WORK

The Delhi Police communications system — the control room, wireless centres, and the communication arrangements of stations and units. The posting is in Delhi. The work runs in shifts, because communications operate around the clock.

WORK CULTURE

This is a technical post and its setting differs from patrolling and investigation, but the pressure is not less — only of a different kind. Communications run around the clock, so the work is in shifts and night duty is ordinary. The person in the control room is the first to receive information nobody else yet has, and sending it onward to the right place, at the right time, in clear words, is their responsibility. The demand here is mental rather than physical: holding concentration over long stretches, staying calm in an emergency, and being exact in a message — because a wrong or incomplete one can send a team working on the ground in the wrong direction. Looking after the equipment is also this cadre's responsibility, so technical work and operation run together. In return the post offers an unusual combination: membership of a police organisation and the standing of the uniform, regular use of a technical skill, and direct appointment at Head Constable rank on a Class 12 or ITI qualification.

WHO HIRES

- Delhi Police — the control room and communication units
- Equivalent communication posts exist in other state police forces and in the Central Armed Police Forces
- Delhi Police stations and district units
- The same technical skill also works in the telecommunications and electronics industry

DEMAND (2026)

The need for communications in police organisations is a standing one and does not shrink as technology changes — its form changes instead — so the need for this cadre persists. Three things should be known. First, this recruitment does not come every year and the number of posts is limited, so do not build a plan around it alone. Second, the qualification condition changes the shape of the competition in the candidate's favour: Class 12 with science and mathematics, or one specific ITI trade — either condition confines applicants to those who took that particular path. The crowd here is smaller than for the general Class 12 posts. Third, the same technical qualification carries in several other directions — communication posts in other state police forces and the central forces, the telecommunications and electronics industry, and technical maintenance work. Time spent on that ITI trade is therefore not a bet on one notice. One thing to be clear about — the "demand" described above counts posts, not your chance of getting one. Selection is by open competition and the number of applicants runs to many times the number of posts, so most candidates are not selected in any given recruitment. That is not an argument against this career; it is an argument against making it your only plan. Keep studying or building a skill alongside your preparation, so that the year is not lost whichever way the result goes.

7 Career growth

- 1 Head Constable (AWO/TPO) — the entry post, central Pay Matrix Level 4 (basic ₹25,500)
- 2 Assistant Sub-Inspector (Communications) — by service and departmental promotion
- 3 Sub-Inspector (Communications) — on further promotion
- 4 Inspector (Communications) and above — the senior level of the communications cadre

The starting figure is the first cell of Level 4 of the central pay matrix, taken from the Commission's own pay-scale list. It is basic pay; dearness allowance, house rent allowance and the police and uniform allowances are added on top, and because the posting is in Delhi the house rent allowance makes a noticeable difference. It is useful to read this figure against a reference point: this portal's GD Constable page shows an entry level of Level 3 (₹21,700), so adding Class 12 with science and mathematics, or one specific ITI trade, moves entry one level up — which is particularly worth knowing for a student doing an ITI. One caution: pay matrix level numbers do not mean the same thing in the state and at the Centre; compare the rupees, not the level numbers. The mid-level and senior figures are approximate and are not confirmed from any official pay statement; read them as a direction, not a promise. The starting figure is BASIC PAY, so that it can be compared directly against other careers. Dearness allowance (60% of basic since 1 January 2026) and house rent allowance are added on top of it, so take-home pay is appreciably higher. The mid-level and senior figures are approximate monthly income including allowances, not basic pay. Note — in Rajasthan a direct recruit is a probationer-trainee for the first 2 years and is paid a fixed remuneration, not the pay scale; dearness allowance and house rent allowance are not payable in those two years (Rajasthan Service Rules, rule 7(30A)). The full pay scale applies once probation is completed. The figures above rest on the Rajasthan 7th pay matrix, which is what applies as of 17 August 2026. The Terms of Reference of the 8th Central Pay Commission were approved on 28 October 2025 and it must report within 18 months of its constitution. State governments normally adopt a Central Pay Commission with modifications, and later than the Centre does — so Rajasthan pay will be revised too, though by how much and when is not yet settled.

8 The good parts · The challenges

The good parts

- An ITI National Trade Certificate is accepted as an alternative to 10+2 — rare on this portal
- Direct recruitment at Head Constable rank, one step above constable
- The specific qualification conditions keep competition lower than for general Class 12 posts
- For widows and divorced women the upper age limit is admissible up to 35 to 40 years

The challenges

- The ITI trade is highly specific — no similar trade will serve in its place
- The paper is at Class 12 level, so an ITI candidate must prepare science and mathematics separately
- Shift work and night duty, because communications run around the clock
- The recruitment does not come every year and the number of posts is limited
