Pharmacists work in hospitals, medical stores, pharmaceutical companies and drug-control departments. In India you can practise legally only after registering as a Registered Pharmacist with a State Pharmacy Council.

3 What you need

INTERESTS

- Interest in medicines, chemistry and human health
- Helping people and giving them correct guidance
- Enjoying precise, detail-oriented work

ABILITIES

- Strong numeracy and focus so doses are never miscalculated
- Good memory and scientific grasp of drug names, effects and interactions
- Clear communication and a strong sense of responsibility

4 How to get there

- 1 Complete Class 11–12 Science with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Maths (PCB/PCM).
- 2 After Class 12 join the 2-year D.Pharm or 4-year B.Pharm (via entrance test/merit).
- 3 After D.Pharm complete the mandatory 3-month / 500-hour practical training.
- 4 Register with the Rajasthan Pharmacy Council to become a Registered Pharmacist — the legal condition to practise.
- 5 Optionally pursue higher study: M.Pharm (specialisation) or the 6-year Pharm.D (clinical pharmacy).

MAIN EXAMS

- RUHS Pharmacy Admission Test (RUHS-CUET) — the main state route to B.Pharm/D.Pharm.
- REAP (Rajasthan Pharmacy Admission Process) — counselling-based admission to many private B.Pharm colleges.
- GPAT — national exam for M.Pharm admission and scholarships.
- NIPER JEE — for some national institutes (M.Pharm/PhD).

Every medical store legally needs a registered pharmacist, so entry-level roles are always available; higher-paying QA, regulatory and clinical roles are growing fast. (2026)

Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw

Founder of Biocon — from a rented garage to Asia's leading biopharma

Rejected from brewing jobs because 'it's a man's work,' Kiran started Biocon in 1978 in a rented garage with just Rs 10,000; her first employee was a retired mechanic. She built it into Asia's largest insulin maker, producing affordable cancer and diabetes medicines.
