## 1 About this career

A Doors & Windows Installer (Fixer) is the skilled tradesperson who fits wooden, aluminium and uPVC doors and windows on construction sites. They first measure, position, level and secure the frames and subframes, then hang the shutters with hinges, handles and locks so that everything opens and closes smoothly and stays weather-tight. It is hands-on, detail-oriented work done with both hand tools and machines, offering steady employment in India's fast-growing construction and interiors industry — and, with experience, a path to running one's own contracting business or shop.

## 3 What you need

### INTERESTS

- Interest in building and fitting things by hand
- Keen to work in the construction and interiors world
- Enjoy working with wood, aluminium and tools

### ABILITIES

- Physical fitness and stamina
- Ability to follow clear instructions
- Accuracy in measurement and attention to detail

### KEY SKILLS

- Measuring, fitting and levelling door/window frames and subframes
- Installing wooden, aluminium and uPVC doors and windows

- Fitting and adjusting hinges, handles, locks and fittings
- Reading drawings and cutting to measurement
- Following safety rules at the worksite
- Safe use of hand tools and power tools (drill, cutter)
- Sealing, weatherproofing and finishing

#### 4 How to get there

- 1 Complete Class 8 and reach the age of 18.
- 2 Enrol in the NSQF Level 4 door/window fixer or carpenter trade at an NSDC/FFSC/ITI centre.
- 3 Practise frame fitting, tool handling and measuring-cutting hands-on.
- 4 Gain on-site experience as a helper with a contractor or fabricator.
- 5 With experience, move from assistant fixer to lead fixer, and later start your own contracting.
- 6 In Rajasthan, RSLDC/PMKVY centres also offer free training and placement support.

Under most government schemes (NSDC, JSS, RSLDC, PMKVY) this training is free or very low-cost. Government ITI carpenter-trade fees are minimal; private woodworking/fabrication courses can cost roughly ₹5,000–25,000.

## 6 What the work is like

#### WHERE YOU WORK

Residential complexes, housing societies, school and college buildings, construction agencies, interior and fabrication workshops.

#### WORK CULTURE

Typically 5–6 days a week, 8–9 hours a day; shift duty and overtime are common. The work is mostly on the construction site, standing, amid dust and noise. This field also offers some opportunities for persons with disabilities.

**DEMAND (2026)**

Construction of housing, smart cities and commercial buildings is expanding fast in Rajasthan and across India, so every new building steadily needs skilled installers to fit doors and windows. The rising use of uPVC and aluminium windows has further improved opportunities for trained workers. Experienced fixers can easily start their own contracting, making this a stable and self-reliant career.

Per Indeed (2026), a carpenter/fitter in India earns on average about ₹27,695/month, while PayScale puts door-window installation work at roughly ₹10,200–26,000/month. Income is limited at the helper/assistant stage but rises considerably with experience, specialisation in uPVC/aluminium and starting one's own contracting.

- Steady demand for a skilled tradesperson in the growing construction and interiors industry
- A good, self-reliant career through skill even with limited schooling
- A clear path to run one's own contracting or shop after gaining experience

**The challenges**

- Dusty, noisy, hot site conditions and long hours
- Risk of injury from tools and machines; safety is essential
- Pay is limited at entry level and work can be seasonal

### Rajesh Sharma

India's Cabinet Making competitor at WorldSkills Lyon 2024

From a modest family in Bihar, Rajesh Sharma trained so hard in woodworking and joinery that at the 2024 WorldSkills Competition in Lyon, France he represented India in Cabinet Making and won the country's first-ever Medallion of Excellence in that skill. His story shows that even from a humble start in a skilled woodworking trade — doors, windows and furniture — discipline and practice can build national and international recognition and a stable career.

She believes there should be no restrictions simply because she is a woman — both men and women can take up any field. Her journey inspires every girl who wants a self-reliant career in the woodworking, door-window or furniture trades.
